Show Rules

-GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS A MUST!

-All Riders while mounted must be wearing proper helmets at all times (no exceptions)

-Riders must be ready to go in ring when their class is being called.

-No Stallions allowed on Property.

-No Dogs allowed (sorry safety first)

-Pre-entries Close Thursday at 12:00 noon prior to show date. Post-entries are closed as of 12:00 Noon on show date.

-All entries must be paid in full one class prior.

-No refunds without a vet or doctors certificate

-If scratching from a class, please advise ring steward at least one class prior.

-Division prices and Individual class prices available.

-Ribbons will be presented 1st - 6th place, with a division champion and reserve champion at each show.

-Year End Division Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded at the last show of the series. Based on points awarded to Rider, Rider must have shown in at least three shows to be eligible.

-Water and washrooms are available.

-Please abide by the car parking areas and the trailer parking areas. Speed is 10mph. Please use extreme caution as horse and riders will be sharing the same access points.

-Oak Ridges Equestrian Centre reserves the right to revise schedule if required.

-no longeing allowed in Warm up area, while others are riding .

-unruly or unsafe animals will need to be removed from the property at Oak Ridges Equestrian Centre discretion.

(A) Leadline Division is for riders who are not yet riding on their own and need some assistance. Riders entering in this Division may NOT enter any other divisions.

(B) Walk/Trot Division is for riders who are learning to walk and trot on their own. Riders will be asked for sitting and rising trot and should be able to handle their horse on their own while doing so. Riders entering in this division may NOT enter in any other divisions.

(C) Walk/Trot/Canter Division is for riders who can W/T/C and manage their horse while doing so. Depending on number of entries the class may be split for the canter, as safety is first. Riders entering in this Division may NOT enter in lower divisions.

(D) Cross Rail Division is for riders who are learning to jump. Riders may trot or canter this course. Riders entering in this division may NOT enter in 2' or 2' 6" divisions.

(E) Hunter over fences 2' division is for riders that are ready to canter their course. Riders entering this division may NOT enter 1' or 2' 6" division.

(F) Hunter over fences 2' 6" division is for riders that are ready to canter their course. Riders entering this division may NOT enter 1' or 2' division.
